

Writing May 4 - 8

Wednesday: Remember the story, Dust Bowl-North Texas, 1934? We read this back in the fall/winter time. First, re-read that story. Next, look back and choose your key words. (If you brought your writing notebook home, then you probably already have that done!) Take a picture of your key words and send them to Mrs. Rissman.

Thursday: We are going to write a narrative essay this week. You are familiar with this type of essay as you probably wrote these in 1st, 2nd, or 3rd grade. It's like writing your own story. But we're not just going to make it up. Read the narrative prompt. Our narrative essay will be about that! We will pretend to be Emily in the story and write a journal entry she may have recorded the day she and her family left their home in Texas. Grab a piece of paper to create your prewrite and keep your key words by you. Watch my video and follow along! When you are done, take a snapshot and send me your prewrite. We will only begin to fill it out today.

Friday: Take out your prewrite and key words from yesterday. Watch my video and follow along. Take a picture of your prewrite and send it to Mrs. Rissman. You should have the middle filled out now. We will continue this writing piece next week- put it somewhere safe!
